Content: The Dearborn Works Program is an 8-week initiative designed to support women entrepreneurs in building and growing their businesses. Participants will engage in training workshops, financial literacy courses, and professional development sessions while networking with other entrepreneurs. The program includes ongoing coaching support for 12 months post-completion and offers \$3,500 in seed funding for business development needs.

Who Qualifies?: The program is open to women entrepreneurs who live in or operate a business in Dearborn. Applicants must be in the ideation phase or have been in business for five years or less. Participants must commit to attending all sessions and working with AAWBC coaches for a year after the program to track progress and growth.

Dates/Times: The program runs in the fall of 2025. Classes are held on select Wednesdays from 6:00 PM – 8:00 PM and Saturdays from 9:00 AM – 11:00 AM. Most sessions are in person, with up to two virtual classes on Zoom. Attendance is mandatory to qualify for seed funding.
